

Close Up Magic Risk Assessment

All activities are considered very low risk and and potential hazards are considered very unlikely.

Hazard	People/Person At Risk	Action Taken	Notes
Tripping and Falling	Entertainer and Public	Keep performing area tidy. If playing cards are dropped, performance must be stopped and pick the cards immediately.	
Cuts	Entertainer and Public	Ensure that any knife blade is covered when not in use. When uncovered only the performer may handle knives.	
Paper Cuts	Entertainer and Public	Care to be taken while using playing cards and envelopes.	
Liquid Spillages	Entertainer and Public	Care taken by performer when in close proximity to beverages. If spilt, perform must avoid area during performance.	
Choking Hazards	Public	Ensure props are only handles by the performer.
